No Surprises Act

Health care providers are required to provide a Good Faith Estimate upon request or at the time of scheduling healthcare services. A Good Faith Estimate is an estimate of expected charges provided to individuals who are **not** enrolled in a health plan or who are not seeking to file a claim with their health plan. You have the right to receive a Good Faith Estimate for the total expected cost of any non-emergency services.

If you plan to pay out of pocket, please ask me for a Good Faith Estimate prior to your first appointment, or at any point during treatment.
